



**REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS:
NEW MEDIA INSTALLATION
AT THE MUSEUM OF FLIGHT**

DEADLINE: MARCH 10, 2023

ABOUT:

On June 10, 2023 The Museum of Flight will boldly depart from its traditional flightpath to host a museum-wide, community-focused celebration connecting the region's vibrant arts scene with its rich aerospace history. **Art+Flight** will exhibit artwork in all mediums, plus offer interactive mural painting, music, dance and plenty of family activities. Guest speakers and engaging community events will regularly enhance the celebration through January 7, 2024.

The new media installation will be in Room 2 within the William E. Boeing Red Barn, the birthplace of the Boeing Airplane Company, that is part of The Museum of Flight's Collection and seamlessly integrated into the footprint of the Museum.

The location offers a warm, rustic appeal with its historic wooden architecture.

Artist will work closely with The Museum of Flight exhibition team to develop a digital and iterative experience for visitors that may change over the course of the exhibition. The resulting artwork will be an immersive installation in a light controlled environment.

Artists must be familiar with working in a museum/gallery setting, and comfortable interacting with visitors and speaking freely about their process and inspiration.

The following equipment can be made available to support the installation:

- (4) Video projectors, two on two walls
 - Content delivered from networked BrightSign players
- Other technology and installation support, *as required*

ARTIST FEE: \$10,000

TIMELINE:

- Friday, March 10, 2023 - Submission Deadline
- Friday, March 24, 2023 - Acceptance Notifications Begin
- April 2023 - Installation Planning Meeting with Exhibition Design Team (*mutually agreed upon date*)
- May 22 - June 2, 2023 – Installation Period (*dates can adjust based on proposal*)
- Friday, June 2 – Artwork Completion Deadline
- Friday, June 9, 2023 - Opening Event
- June 10, 2023 - January 7, 2024 - Exhibition Period
- January 8-19, 2024 – De-Installation Period

ELIGIBILITY:

Artists currently living in, or who are past residents of, the Pacific Northwest (Washington, Oregon, and Idaho) who are 18 years or older.

Artists from diverse backgrounds, including women, BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, People of Color), people with disabilities, or who are from other marginalized groups are encouraged to apply.

*Museum of Flight staff, volunteers and Board members **are not** eligible to participate.*

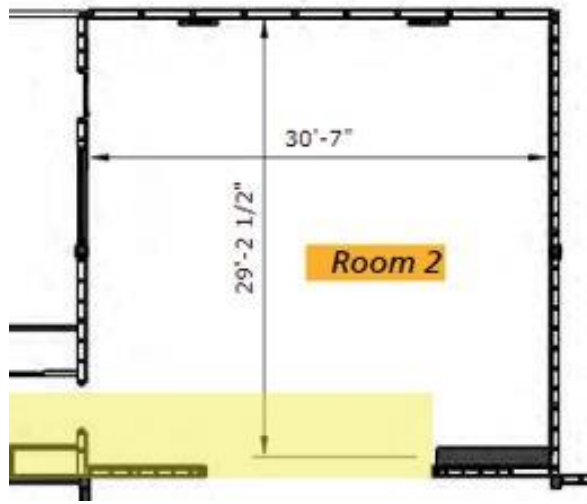
LIMITATIONS:

The following materials and activities **are not allowed** in any of the Museum’s indoor spaces: candles/open flame, glitter, sand, dirt or sawdust, rice or birdseed, dyes or food coloring, spray adhesives, welding, live plants or animals.

Ventilation is limited, and fumes must be kept to a minimum.

The artwork installation may not alter the structure of the building in any manner.

FLOOR PLAN:



PLEASE NOTE: Highlighted areas mark open space with no artwork (4 ft. from walls).

Doorway openings into this space measure 70" W x 70" H.

SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

- **1-5 images (5 images, 12GB max) example of past artwork in JPG or PNG format.**
 - Files should be labeled: lastname_firstname_title_yearcreated
- **Concept Design for Installation (3-pages, 10GB max)**
- **Proposal Summary (PDF Format, 1-page, 10GB max)**
 - Description of Artwork - please call out any connection to specific aircraft, artifact or ephemera related to flight or space-travel
 - Materials & Equipment List
 - Description of Installation Process
 - *Optional:* 1-3 links to videos showing past installations of specific piece or other pieces
- **Artist Page (PDF Format, 1-page, 1GB max)**
 - Artist Statement (400 words max)
 - Artist Bio (400 words max)
- **CV/Resume (PDF Format, 1-page, 1GB max)**

SELECTION PROCESS:

A committee of notable local curators will review all submissions to recommend top candidates. Submissions by top candidates will be reviewed and approved by The Museum of Flight based on the committee's recommendation. Only a single artist or artist team will be selected for this opportunity.
